Flor Meija was recently awarded A Teacher Recruitment Scholarship. The goal of the Teacher Recruitment Scholarship is to increase the ethnic diversity of teachers in Wasatch Front schools. This scholarship supports students of diverse backgrounds to become teachers and return to their communities as educational leaders and mentors for future generations. Students begin their postsecondary education at Salt Lake Community College. Upon completing their Associate's degree, they transfer to the University of Utah to earn a Bachelor's degree in Teacher Education. The scholarship award includes \$500 per semester from the school district for fees and books for a minimum of four semesters; a tuition waiver from SLCC for a maximum of two years; and \$5,000 per year for tuition at the University of Utah for a maximum of two years.
