Then he returned to New York to receive his Master's degree in Adolescent Education with a Math emphasis from Pace University while teaching newly-arrived immigrant students in Queens. **Ryan** recently finished all the requirements for a level 4 math endorsement. He enjoys spending time with his family, hiking, camping, backpacking, fishing, and geocaching.
