Our Energy Future

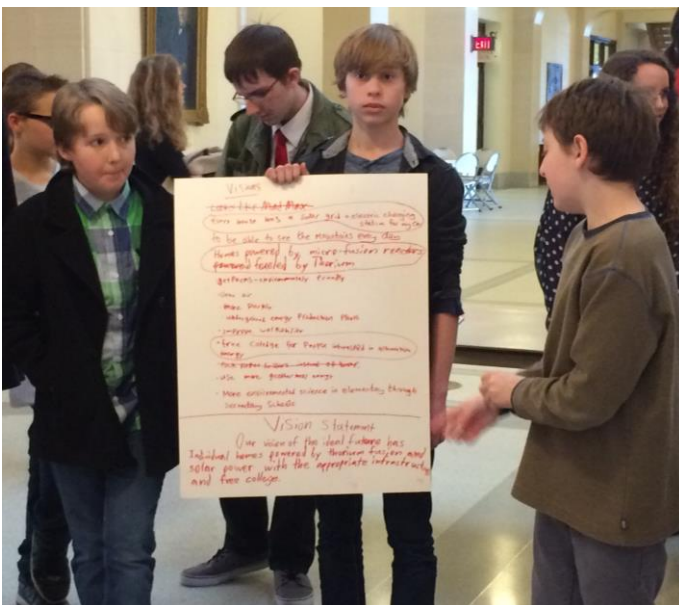
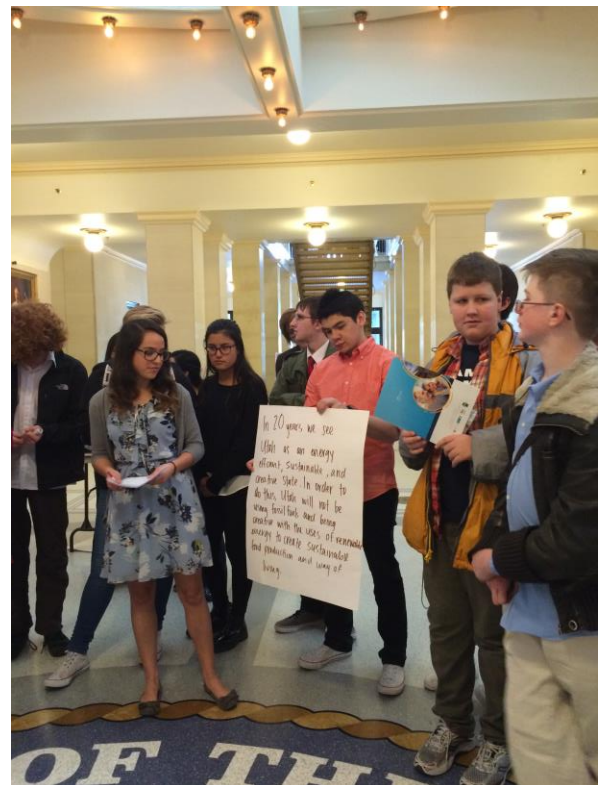
