Breaking News! Gina will be working part-time as a consultant for our school during this important transition. So happy she'll still be around!

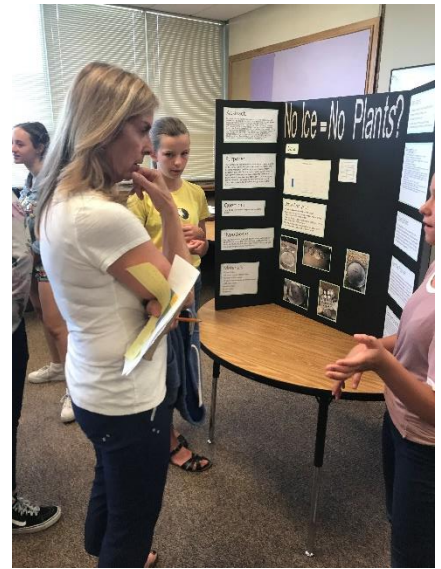
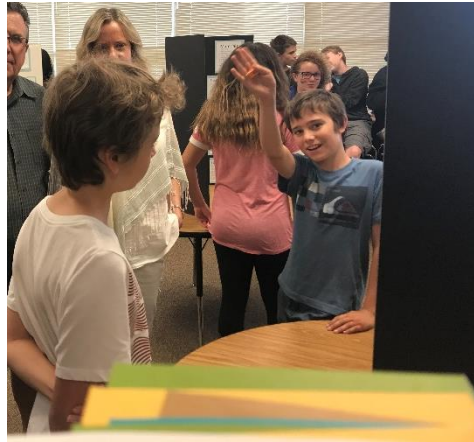
