Show Times: Friday, October 13th, at 7PM; Saturday, October 14th, at 11 AM and 1PM

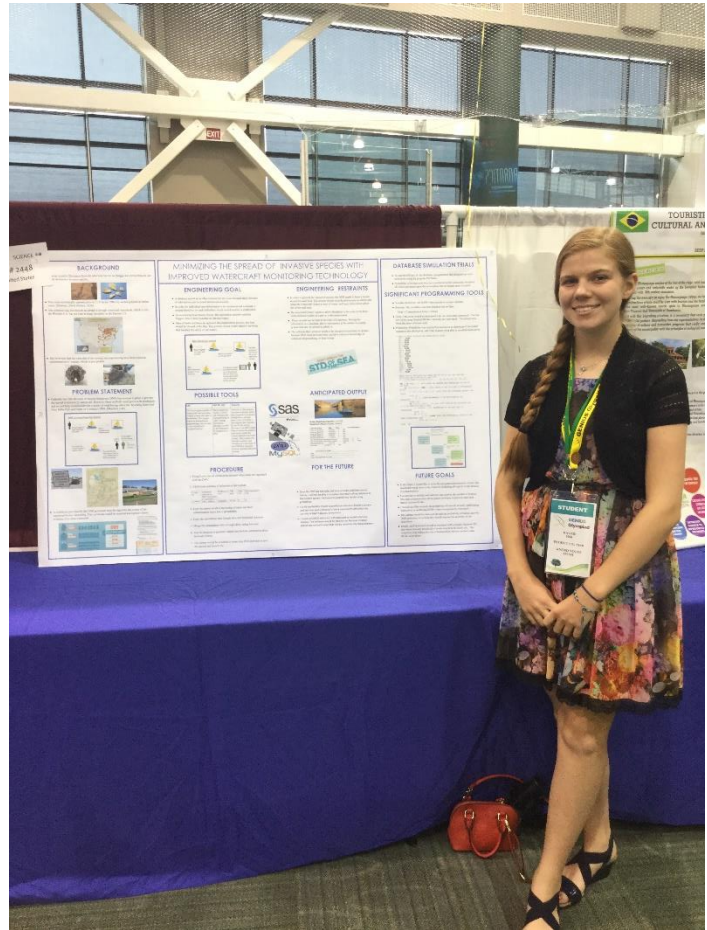
