

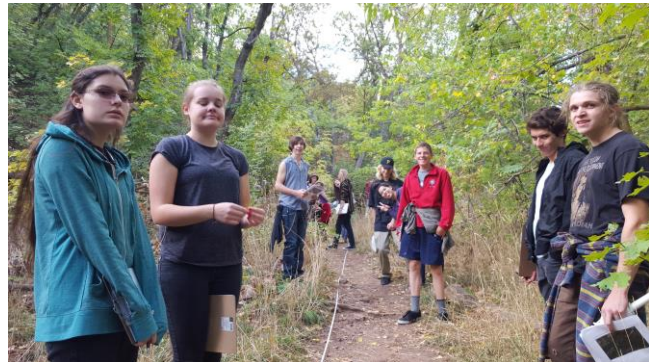
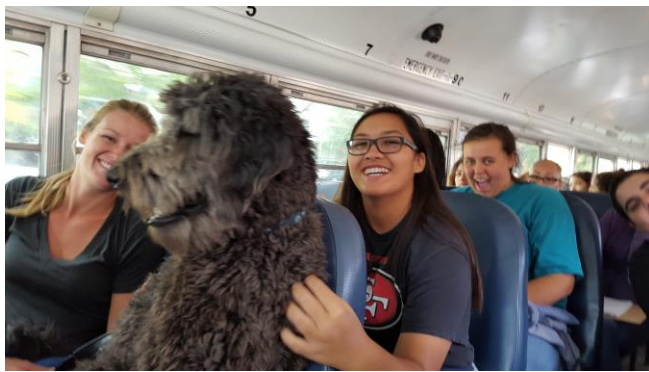

West High School  
Wednesday, October 14th  
\$25

Students must go to the treasurer to sign up and pay for the exam

Highland High School  
Wednesday, October 14th  
\$25 for non-Highland students

East High School  
Contact treasurer October 1st to see if tests are available
